### **Grants Available: York County Community Foundation Now Accepting Applications from Nonprofits**

**YORK COUNTY, SC** – The York County Community Foundation is currently accepting applications for its 2024 grant program. Eligible applicants include 501(c)(3) publicly supported charities, churches and religious organizations, governmental agencies, and educational institutions.

Grants will be awarded in support of a broad range of charitable purposes, but priority will be given to proposals that address a community need, specifically arts and culture; education; environment; food, agriculture, and nutrition; health; housing and shelter; and human services. All projects and programs must serve residents of York County.

Award amounts will be determined based on the merits of the proposed project and the Foundation's available funds. Previous awards have ranged from \$1,000 to \$5,000.

To begin the application process, visit [fftcgrants.communityforce.com](https://fftcgrants.communityforce.com) and select "York County Community Foundation" to access the online application. Returning applicant organizations can log in to the Online Grants Center using their previously established ID and password. First-time applicant organizations can create a new account. **Completed applications must be submitted online by noon on Friday, July 26.** The online application closes promptly at 12 p.m. and will not accept late submissions.
